You can always talk to a trusted adult.

Our Safety Rules

1. Stay on the school site
2. Never open safeguarding doors
3. Walk inside the building
4. Listen to adults
5. Stay with your class and an adult
6. Keep each other safe
7. Tell an adult if you are worried

1. Stay on the school site

NEVER leave the school site during the school day without an adult.

If you are upset or need to go somewhere: STOP • FIND AN ADULT • TELL THEM.

2. Safeguarding doors

|| Safeguarding doors are NEVER opened by children.

Adults will NEVER ask you to open a safeguarding door.

Never open, hold open or let someone through a safeguarding door.

Safeguarding doors are for adults – never children.

3. Walk inside the school

 **Inside = WALKING feet.**

We walk – we don't run.

Walk carefully on stairs and look where you are going.

Walking helps keep everyone safe.

4. Listen to adults

 **STOP • LISTEN • FOLLOW THE INSTRUCTION**

Adults may say:

“Stop.” “Wait here.” “Come with me.” “Stay with your class.”

These instructions are there to help keep you safe.

5. Stay with your class and an adult



Adults need to know where you are.

Never go into a room on your own unless an adult is there with you.

Never go onto the playground or another outside area without an adult.

Don't wander, hide, or run away.

6. We keep each other safe

♥□ **We look after ourselves AND each other.**

We don't push, hurt, bully or dare others to do dangerous things.

We don't encourage someone to break a safety rule or leave school.

If you see something unsafe: TELL AN ADULT.

Speaking up is being brave.

If you are worried – TELL

 **Worried** •  **Sad** •  **Frightened** •  **Angry** •  **Uncomfortable**

Tell your teacher, another trusted adult, or one of our DSLs.

If the first adult doesn't listen, tell another adult.

Keep telling until someone helps.

What if an adult gives you an instruction?

 STOP

 LISTEN

 DO WHAT THE ADULT HAS ASKED

You can ask questions afterwards if you don't understand.

Safeguarding Superpowers!

 **Open gate → NO! Stay in school and tell an adult.**

 **Safeguarding door → NO! Children never open them.**

 **Running indoors → NO! Walking feet.**

 **Empty playground → NO! Wait for an adult.**

 **Something worries you → TELL A TRUSTED ADULT.**

Let's say our rules together

 I stay on the school site during the school day unless an adult takes me.

 I NEVER open safeguarding doors.

 Adults will NEVER ask me to open a safeguarding door.

 I WALK inside the school building.

 I listen to adults.

 I stay with my class and an adult.

 If something worries me, I tell an adult and keep telling until someone helps.

Our Safeguarding Promise

VALUED

LISTENED TO

CARED FOR

Every person is precious and deserves dignity, kindness and care.

Remember: STOP • LISTEN • TELL

 **STOP** when an adult gives you a safety instruction.

 **LISTEN** carefully to the adults who are looking after you.

 **TELL** an adult if something is worrying you or doesn't feel right.

Final Message

Stay on the school site.

Never open safeguarding doors.

Walk inside the building.

Listen to adults.

Stay with your class and an adult.

Tell someone if you are worried.
